Dady goes beyond the role of restaurant owner, applying familial values to create tight-knit bonds with members of his team and residents of the San Antonio community. The family-owned Jason Dady Restaurant Group is helmed by Dady, alongside brother, Jake (Co-Owner/COO), and wife, Crystal (Co-Owner/CFO).

The Jason Dady Restaurant Group encompasses four restaurants as well as catering and events services. His concepts now include: Tre Trattoria (2007), offering Tuscan-Italian family-style dining at the San Antonio Museum of Art; family-friendly Texas pit ‘cue at the award-winning Two Bros BBQ Market (2008); Range (2017), a Tuscan Italian Steakhouse, is located along the famed Riverwalk of Downtown San Antonio; and Jardin (2020) located on the San Antonio Botanical Garden campus encapsulates the flavors found in small towns along the Mediterranean using fresh and natural ingredients. The catering and events branch applies Chef’s unique signature and unwavering commitment of excellence to every event, big or small. From office luncheons to classy cocktails parties to elaborate five-course themed dinners, Chef Jason Dady’s expertise is creating memorable events.



At the forefront of the San Antonio Culinary Scene, Chef Dady serves as Board Chair for Visit San Antonio Culinary Advisory, serves on the Board for Culinaria and is a Culinary Institute of America Fellow.
